

SENTENCE OF HINGSTON J

I am told in this report that you are already on probation for burglary and you have already breached the conditions, why was that? Don't you like probation? You realize that when the Court gives you probation it's a chance for you; otherwise - watch your fingers - in you go. Do you appreciate that? The Probation Service has suggested as you will read in that report that you be given another chance and that you serve your probation in Aitutaki with your natural parents, what do you think about, do you want to go back to Aitutaki.
