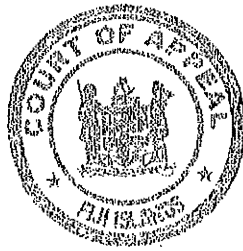

DECISION

[1] The appellants apply for an adjournment on the ground that the court record is incomplete and that they are not ready to argue their appeals. They pointed out to the Court that the record does not include the transcript of evidence led at trial, assessors' opinions and judgment. They also say that the summing up is not complete.
