JUDGMENT

1. The two accused were charged under the following count:

<u>COUNT 1</u>

Statement of Offence

Murder: Contrary to Sections 199 and 200 of the Penal Code, Cap. 17

Particulars of Offence

ALESI NALAVE TAWAKE d/o Ranjit Kumar and **KELERA MARAMA** on the 10th day of June 2004 at **NADI** in the **WESTERN DIVISION** murdered **XIAOLU LI** also known as **SHERLY LI.**

- 2. All three assessors unanimously found both accused guilty of the above charge.
- 3. I direct myself in accordance with the law and the evidence which I discussed in my summing up to the assessors.
- 4. Considering the nature of the evidence before the court, I am convinced that the prosecution had proved the case beyond reasonable doubt.
- 5. I find the verdict of the assessors were not perverse. It was open to them to reach such a conclusion on the evidence. I concur with their verdict. Considering all, I find the accused guilty as charged in respect of murder.
- 6. Accordingly I convict Alesi Nalave Tawake and Kelera Marama for Murder contrary to Sections 199 and 200 of the Penal Code, Cap 17.
