SEA PORTS MANAGEMENT ACT 2005 (No. 8 of 2005)

Notification on Declaration of Port of Oinafa—Rotuma

In exercise of powers conferred upon me under section 5(2) and 3 of the Sea Port Management Act (No. 8 of 2005), after consultation with the Director of the Fiji Islands Maritime Safety Administration, the Native Fisheries Commission and the Chief Executive Officer of the relevant port management company, I hereby declare the areas defined in the following, to be—

THE PORT OF OINAFA - ROTUMA

Repeal

1. The Notification on Declaration of Port of Rotuma (Legal Notice No. 72/2008) is hereby repealed.

The Seaward Limits for Oinafa Port.

2. The seaward boundary of Oinafa Port originates at "Point 1", East of Oinafa, then out to "Point 2", on a bearing of 000° (T) and a distance of 1.6 nautical miles. From "Point 2" it goes westward to "Point 3" on a bearing of 270° (T) for a distance of 3.7 nautical miles. From "Point 3" it goes south to "Point 4", on a bearing of 180° (T) and a distance of 1.1 nautical miles and thence along the high water mark to "Point 1".
