KING'S REGULATION

TO MAKE FURTHER PROVISION FOR THE ENGAGEMENT
AND PAYING OFF OF LABOUR WITHIN THE BRITISH
SOLOMON ISLANDS PROTECTORATE.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the
Western Pacific under the provisions of the Pacific Order in
Council 1893.

In the name of His Majesty, GEORGE THE FIFTH, by the Grace of
God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland
and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender
of the Faith, Emperor of India.

[11th September, 1922]

1. This Regulation may be cited for all purposes as the Solomons
Labour Regulation 1922 and shall be read and construed with the
Solomons Labour Regulation 1921 hereinafter referred to as the
principal Regulation.

SHORT TITLE.

2. Whenever by sections twenty-four, twenty-five and fifty-nine
of the principal Regulation any act or thing is required to be done
by or before a District Officer the same may be done by and before
any person duly authorised to do so by the Resident Commissioner
in writing.
