KING'S REGULATION

TO AMEND THE TONGA (ALIEN ENEMY TRADE DISPOSAL) REGULATION 1916.

Made by His Britannic Majesty's High Commissioner for the Western Pacific under the provisions of the Pacific Order in Council 1893.

In the name of His Majesty, George the Fifth, by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India.

[22nd December, 1916.]

1. This Regulation may be cited for all purposes as the Tonga (Alien Enemy Trade Disposal) Amendment, No. 2, Regulation 1916.

SHORT TITLE.

2. Section three of the Tonga (Alien Enemy Trade Disposal) Regulation 1916, is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor:—

AMENDMENT OF SECTION 3 OF KING'S REGULATION 1 OF 1916.

“ 3. If any question arises as to whether any person
“ is an alien enemy or not, or whether any body cor-
“ porate is incorporated in enemy territory or not, a
“ certificate under the hand of the Consul shall be
“ sufficient proof for all purposes that such person is

“ an alien enemy or that such body corporate is incorporated in enemy territory, and it shall be incumbent upon the person alleging that such person is not an alien enemy or that such body corporate is not incorporated in enemy territory to prove the same.”
