Public Law No. 7 - 64

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 7-19, as amended by Public Law No. 7-36, by amending sections 1, 2, 13 and 16 to appropriate the sum of \$204,969 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1992, as supplemental funding for the operations of the executive branch and the legislative branch of the National Government, to amend the budget for Compact section 221(b), to raise the employment ceiling of the National Government, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 7-19 is hereby amended
2 to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. Operating expenses of the executive branch.

4 The sum of \$10,183,022, or so much thereof as may be
5 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
6 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
7 ending September 30, 1992, for the operations of the
8 executive branch of the National Government of the
9 Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1992.
