AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 6-67, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 7-77 and 8-92, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 7-77 and 8-92, to transfer funds between line items to reflect a prior reprogramming action by the allottee, to modify the use of certain funds appropriated therein for Yap State public projects, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 6-67, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 7-77 and 8-92, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
