**PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-76**

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AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 16-49, as amended by Public Law No. 16-68, by amending the title and sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 thereof, to modify the use of certain funds previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the States of Pohnpei and Chuuk, and to offer technical amendments thereto, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. The title of Public Law No. 16-49 as amended by  
2 Public Law No. 16-68, is hereby further amended to read as  
3 follows:

4                   “To appropriate the sum of \$2,215,000 from the  
5 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia  
6 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, for  
7 the purpose of funding public projects and social  
8 programs in the four States of the Federated States  
9 of Micronesia, and for other purposes.”

10           Section 2. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-49, as amended  
11 by Public Law No. 16-68, is hereby further amended to read as  
12 follows:

13                   “Section 1. The sum of \$2,215,000, or so much  
14 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated  
15 from the General Fund of the Federated States of  
16 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
17 2011, for the purpose of funding public projects and  
18 social programs in the four States of the Federated

1 States of Micronesia.”

2 Section 3. Section 2 of Public Law No. 16-49, as amended  
3 by Public Law No. 16-68, is hereby further amended to read as  
4 follows:

5 “Section 2. Of the sum of \$2,215,000 appropriated by  
6 this act, \$205,000 is apportioned for Kosrae State  
7 for public projects and social programs.
