PUBLIC LAW NO. 19-04

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-117, as amended by Public Law No. 18-120, by amending sections 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use, allottee and lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people in the States of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 18-117 is
2 hereby amended to read as follows:

2 Section 5. Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-117 is
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
5 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
6 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
7 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
8 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
9 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
10 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
11 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
12 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
13 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
14 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
15 State. The allottee of funds appropriated under
16 sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of
17 the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee,
18 PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under
19 sections 3(a)(b)(c)(d)(e)(f)(g)(h)(i)(j)(k)(l) and (m)
20 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government; the allottee
21 of funds appropriation under sections 4(3)(a) and
22 4(3)(f) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
23 Authority; the allottee of funds appropriated under
24 section 4(3)(h) of this act shall be the Meninkeden
25 Lapalap of Madolenimw and the allottee of funds

1 appropriated under section 4(3)(i) of this act shall be
2 the Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti. The allottee of funds
3 appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of
4 section 5 of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk
5 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
6 appropriated under subsection 5(2) of section 5 of this
7 act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority.
8 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4)
9 of section 5 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas
10 Development Authority. The allottee of funds
11 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of section 5 of this
12 act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The
13 authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated
14 by this act to the States of Chuuk, Kosrae and Pohnpei
15 shall lapse on September 30, 2016. All funds
16 appropriated to Yap State that are not allotted by May
17 1, 2016, shall be deposited into the Yap State Trust
18 Fund. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
19 section 2 of this act for Yap State shall report proof
20 of deposit to Congress of the Federated States of
21 Micronesia within 30 days from depositing funds into the
22 Yap State Trust Fund.

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1 Section 6. This act shall become law upon approval by
2 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon
3 its becoming law without such approval.
