

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-106, 18-113, 18-121, 19-05, 19-34 and 19-57, by amending section 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the state of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 18-106, 18-113, 19-05, 19-34 and 19-57, is hereby  
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the \$2,800,000 appropriated in this act,  
5 \$1,200,000 is appropriated for public projects and social  
6 programs for the people of the state of Chuuk.
