PUBLIC LAW NO. 19-140

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-124, as amended by Public Law No. 19-133, by amending sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to deappropriate an amount of \$700,000 from the infrastructure priority projects funding for the states of Kosrae and Chuuk and to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein to fund priority infrastructure projects in the states of Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-124 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. The sum of \$11,300,000, or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
5 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
6 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, for the
7 purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects in
8 all of the four states. The funds appropriated under
9 this section shall be apportioned as follows:

10 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 19-124 is hereby
11 amended to read as follows:

12 "Section 2. Of the \$11,300,000 appropriated under this
13 act, \$1,750,000 shall be apportioned for priority
14 infrastructure projects in the state of Yap.

25 infrastructure projects in the state of Pohnpei.

7 Section 5. of Public Law No. 19-124 is hereby amended
8 to read as follows:

9 "Section 5. Of the \$11,300,000 appropriated under this
10 act, \$5,650,000 shall be apportioned for priority
11 infrastructure projects in the state of Chuuk.

21 Section 6. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-124, as
22 amended by Public Law No. 19-124, is hereby further amended to
23 read as follows:

24 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
25 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be

1 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
2 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
3 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
4 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
5 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
6 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
7 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
8 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
9 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of the
10 State of Yap or his designee. The allottee of the funds
11 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be
12 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
13 his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
14 appropriated under subsections 4(1)(c) through 4(1)(o),
15 4(2)(f), 4(3)(c), 4(3)(d), 4(3)(e), 4(3)(g), 4(3)(k) and
16 4(3)(q), 4(3)(s), 4(4)(b), 4(4)(d), 4(4)(f), shall be
17 the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee
18 of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(b),
19 4(2)(a), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d) and 4(2)(e) shall be the Mayor
20 of Kolonia Town Government; the allottee of funds
21 appropriated under subsections 4(1)(a), 4(2)(b),
22 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i) and 4(2)(j) shall be the
23 Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
24 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the
25 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections

1 (4)(3)(i), 4(3)(0) and 4(3)(r) shall be the Pohnpei
2 Utility Corporation (PUC), the allottee of funds
3 appropriated under subsection 4(3)(j) shall be the
4 Lukenmenlap of Kitti. The allottee of the funds
5 appropriated under section 5 of this act shall be the
6 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The authority
7 of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this
8 act shall lapse on September 30, 2017.

9 Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the
10 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
11 becoming law without such approval.
