

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-121, as amended by Public Law No. 19-130, by amending sections 3, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of the states of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 19-121, as amended by  
2 Public Law No. 19-130, is hereby further amended to read as  
3 follows:

4           "Section 3. Of the sum of \$5,450,000 appropriated by this  
5 act, \$1,100,000 is apportioned to fund public projects and  
6 social programs for the people of the state of Kosrae.

21 Section 4. Section 6 of Public Law No. 19-121, as amended by  
 22 Public Law No. 19-130, is hereby amended to read as follows:

23 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and  
 24 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall  
 25 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for

1 in accordance with applicable laws, including, but  
2 not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.  
3 The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that  
4 these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,  
5 are used solely for the purpose specified in this  
6 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess  
7 of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds  
8 appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the  
9 Governor of Yap State; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of  
10 funds appropriated under section 2(k) shall be the  
11 President of the Federated States of Micronesia. The  
12 allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4  
13 of this act shall be the President of the Federated  
14 States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT  
15 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
16 3(a) through 3(y) - shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak  
17 Municipal Government; the allottee of funds  
18 appropriated under subsections 3(aa) - 3(a10) shall  
19 be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government; the allottee of  
20 funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(l),  
21 4(3)(a), 4(3)(f) and 4(3)(i) of this act shall be the  
22 Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee  
23 of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(a),  
24 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(f), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i),  
25 4(2)(j), 4(2)(k), 4(2)(l) and 4(2)(m) shall be the

1 Secretary of the Department of Transportation,  
2 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee;  
3 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection  
4 4(2)(b) shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation  
5 (PUC); the allottee of funds appropriated under  
6 subsection 4(2)(c) shall be the Office of Fisheries,  
7 Pohnpei State; the allottee of funds appropriated  
8 under subsection 4(2)(n) shall be the Secretary of  
9 the Department of Education or his designee; the  
10 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection  
11 4(3)(b) shall be the Governor of the State of Pohnpei  
12 or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated  
13 under subsections 4(3)(c) and 4(3)(e) of this act  
14 shall be the Meninkeder of Madolenihmw; allottee of  
15 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(d) and  
16 4(3)(m) shall be the Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti. The  
17 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
18 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor  
19 of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of  
20 funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act  
21 shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority.  
22 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection  
23 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas  
24 Development Authority. The allottee of funds  
25 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall

1 be the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority  
2 of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by  
3 this act shall lapse on September 30, 2018."

4 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
5 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
6 becoming law without such approval.
