

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-121, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-130, 19-142, 19-145, 19-158, 20-09, 20-22, 20-51, 20-59, 20-70, 20-123, 20-162, 20-170, 21-35, 21-66, 21-112, 21-127 and 21-176, by amending section 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of the state of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 19-121, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 19-130, 19-142, 19-145, 19-158, 20-59, 21-112 and  
3 21-127, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the sum of \$5,450,000 appropriated by  
5 this act, \$2,550,000 is apportioned to fund public  
6 projects and social programs for the people of the  
7 state of Chuuk.
