Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Act, 1980.

Authorisation

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of \$411,645 to be applied for recurrent expenditure to the service of the year ending on 31 December, 1980.

Appropriation.

3. The sum specified in section 2 shall be appropriated for the supply of the Head of Expenditure specified in Column 1 of the Schedule annexed to this Act.



EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM


This Act charges upon the Consolidated Fund an amount estimated to be required for the Plant and Vehicle Unit Special Fund created last December by Act 8 of 1979. The sum concerned was built up on deposit, with a view to eventual transfer to the Special Fund, out of sums paid by Government departments and others in respect of the hire of Government plant and vehicles.
