OPINION AND ANSWER OF THE TRADITONAL RIGHTS COURT

ACTION TAKEN:

The question put before Panel of the Traditional Rights Court for answer is: AS BETWEEN WANMIJ JEPPA AND TARBINA CLARENCE, WHO IS THE PROPER PERSON TO HOLD THE TITLE OF IROJ EDRIK ON BIKEN ISLAND, AUR ATOLL, REPUBLIC OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS?

ANSWER TO QUESTION: WANMEJ JEPPA

ISSUE(S) IN THIS CASE:

The Complaint in this case was filed on December 8, 2008. The Answer from the Defendant was filed on March 31, 2009. The Complaint ascended from the Land Lease Agreement which started in

1999 between the government of the Republic of the Marshall Islands and those that hold land titles on Biken Island, Aur Atoll.

The Land Lease as described has two Irojlaplap signatures on it, Uduj Benjamin and Rimios Hermios. This may have happened with the intention to expedite the effective date of the land lease. According to Marshallese custom, there cannot be two Iroijlaplap holding the same right at the same time on the same land. However, in this case the Complaint, the Answer, and the documentary evidence all show and agree that Uduj Benjamin and his descendants are the Iroijlaplap of Biken Island. The witnesses who testified in this case also agree that Uduj Benjamin is the Iroijlaplap of Biken Island. The Plaintiff filed the Complaint in disagreement with the Iroijedrik right being signed by the Defendant, Betwell Jeur. Iroijlaplap Laelang Lelwoj, who inherited the title of Iroijlaplap on Biken Island from Iroijlaplap Uduj Benjamin recognized the descending line of Judia Jeppa's family beginning from Iroijlaplap Namidrik Jeik and Tonki Jeppa as shown in Plaintiff Exhibit P-D and Exhibit P-E, that they are the proper persons to hold the Iroijedrik title on Biken Island. Witness Birojki Edmond, who is one of the Alabs on Biken Island, testified that the reason why he recognized Betwel Jeur is because he signed the land lease as an Iroijedrik, and that was his only reason. Judia Jeppa stated in the Complaint that she did not know about the land lease because it was prepared and signed on Majuro Atoll, while she was on Aur Atoll.

There is insufficient evidence, both during the testimony of witnesses and on documentary evidence that were presented in court to prove that Betwell Jeur does hold the Iroijedrik title on Biken Island. Both parties agreed that those under the family lineage of Uduj Benjamin are the rightful Iroijlaplap on Biken Island, and that Laelang Lelwoj was the Iroijlaplap after Uduj Benjamin. Iroijlaplap Laelang Lelwoj was the one, who recognized those under the family lineage of Judia Jeppa, as proper persons to hold the right of Iroijedrik on Biken Island, Aur Atoll. The TRC Panel, who heard this matter, sees that it is proper for Wanmej Jeppa to be the rightful Iroijedrik title holder on Biken Island on the wetos discussed in this case.
