**AN ACT**

to amend section 203 (1) of the Alcohol Restriction Act of 1994, in order to modify certain penalties and for related matters.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE NITIJELA OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS:**

**Section 1. Short Title**

This Act may be cited as the Alcohol Restriction (Penalty Amendment) Act, 2004

**Section 2. Amendment**

Section 203 subsection (1) of the Alcohol Restriction Act of 1994 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**§203. Penalty.**

(1) Any person who purchases, consumes, drinks or possesses alcoholic beverages or other intoxicating liquors, or enters or remains in any bar in the Republic in contravention of the provisions of Section 202 of this Act shall be guilty of an offense and shall upon conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding four hundred dollars (\$400) or to a term of imprisonment for a period not exceeding six (6) months, or both.

**Section 3. Effective Date**

This Act shall take effect on the date of certification, in accordance with the Constitution and the Rules of Procedures of the Nitijela.


