11		(1) Any person who purchases, consumes, drinks or possesses alcoholic
12		beverages or other intoxicating liquors, or enters or remains in any bar in the
13		Republic in contravention of the provisions of Section 202 of this Act shall be
14		guilty of an offense and shall upon conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding
15		four hundred dollars (\$400) or to a term of imprisonment for a period not
16		exceeding six (6) months, or both.
17	Section 3.	Effective Date
18	This 2	Act shall take effect on the date of certification, in accordance with the Constitution
19	and the Rules	s of Procedures of the Nitijela.
