5	I	BE IT ENACTED BY THE NITIJELA OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS	
6	Section 1.	Short Title	
7	This Act may be cited as the Elections and Referenda (Amendment) Act, 2004.		
8	Section 2.	Amendment	
9	Section 109 of the Act is hereby amended in the following manner;		
10	§109	Local government elections.	
11	(1)	Subject to Subsection (2) of this Section, every eligible voter who is registered	
12	under this Chapter with respect to a place within a local government area is qualified to be a		
13	candidate for election to an elective office in the local government.		
14	(2)	Nothing in Subsection (1) of this Section prevents the constitution of a local	
15	government from providing for further qualifications or disqualification for any elective office.		
16	(3)	If any councilman of a local government stands for election for mayor within a	
17	local government in a special election, he shall be deemed to have resigned his office. This shall		
18	apply to any member of the Nitijela running for mayor or councilman and any mayor running for		
19	councilman. T	That resignation shall be deemed to take effect on the date that the candidate

1	certifies to the Chief Electoral Officer in the certificate prescribed by Section 145(l)(c) that he is		
2	willing and qualified to stand for election.		
3	(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of any Act or Local Government Constitution to the		
4	contrary, in all cases where a Local Government Constitution provides that the Mayor or head of		
5	the Local Government be elected by a popular vote of all eligible voters in that electoral district,		
6	the candidate who polls the highest number of votes shall be declared the winner of the		
7	election.		
8	Section 3. Effective Date		
9	This Act shall take effect upon certification in accordance with the provisions of the		
10	Constitution of the Republic of the Marshall Islands and the Rules of procedures of the Nitijela.
