	(1)	The Authority may only use money in the Fund in accordance with
	its budget, ex	cept in the case of unforseen events. In this case the expenditure
	must be appro	oved in writing by the Board.
	(2)	Money received by the Authority for a specific purpose must be
	used only for	that purpose.
	(3)	As used in this Section, "unforeseen events" include events which
	arise out of, a	are incidental to, the functions of the Authority under section 2.3 of
	this Act.	
	(4).	In addition to the expenditures of the Authority as described in
