Prohibition. (1) Smoking in public premises, public vehicles, restaurants and aircrafts 19

Section 3. Effective Date

(2) In all public premises and public vehicles, there shall be conspicuously displayed a sign, "SMOKING IS PROHIBITED", by the owner, manager or the occupier of such premises or vehicle.

(3) By inserting a new section 4 to read as follows:

"§ 4. Restaurant Bars

In the case of restaurants that offer liquor in a bar that is set up or constructed within, adjacent to or adjoining the dining area, the owner or manager of the premises shall designate by very conspicuous means, the division between the bar area and the dining area. The prohibition contained in section 3 above shall apply to the dining area.

(4). To re-number section 4 of the Act to read as follows;

"§ 5 Penalty.

Any person, including the owner, manager or occupier of a public premises, who contravenes the provisions of Sections 3 or 4 of this Act shall be guilty of an offense and shall upon conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding \$2,500.
