## ORDER

The accused is discharged upon entering into his own recognisance in the sum of \$100.00, with his father Jaxon Olsson as surety in the same sum, conditioned that he shall appear and receive judgment when called upon at any time within two years of today and in the meantime to keep the peace and be of good behaviour.
