## ORDER

UPON hearing Mr. Reuben; for the Plaintiff, the Court dismissed the application for an order for Certiorari.

Action No. 11/2001 consequent on the application was also dismissed.

## REASONS.

- 1. There was no decision of the Nauru Lands Committee, advanced in evidence by the Plaintiff, that could have been quashed by the Court.
- 2. Adimim v Eobob a case heard by the Central Court in 1954 adjudged that the phosphate land "ljati" Portion 48, Buada,

should be distributed in a certain way. It appears that the judgment was followed as required in regard to "Ijati". There was nothing left to be done so far as <u>Adimim v Eobob</u> was concerned.

3. If at the time, or some other stage, there was a concern about the distribution of Egago's estate, it should, in the ordinary course of appeal have been then and there dealt with. It is too late to raise it now.
