ORDER

I order that

1. the surviving children of Deirok G. shall continue sharing equally, as tenants of the dwelling house on portion 174 CL Yaren and known as IATKONOBO.
2. a family meeting of the surviving children of Deirok G by the Nauru Lands Committee within 28 days to determine who shall be the occupants of the tenancy
3. in determining the occupancy the Nauru Lands Committee take into account the remarks of the Court in its decision dated 29 April 2004 and the criterion of hardship as expressed in Section 11 (3) of the Nauru Housing Ordinance 1957
4. that this order is to be served on the NLC together with a copy of the judgment
5. there be liberty to apply to all parties
6. there is no order as to costs
