AN ACT

To make interim provision for the withdrawal and expenditure of moneys from the Treasury Fund and the Nauru Housing Fund in payment for goods and services obtained or ordered for the Republic during the first quarter of the financial year ending on the Thirtieth day of September, Two thousand and Two.

(Certified: 18 June 2002)

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of Nauru as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This Act may be cited as the Supply Act 2002.

COMMENCEMENT AND EXPIRY

2: This Act shall come into force on the first day of July, Two Thousand and Two and shall cease to have effect on the first day of October, Two Thousand and Two or upon coming into operation of the Appropriation Law in respect of the financial year ending on the thirtieth day of June, Two Thousand and Three, whichever is the earlier.

WITHDRAWAL OF MONEYS FROM THE TREASURY FUND

3: The sum of \$17, 847,788 (Dollars Seventeen Million Eight Hundred and Forty Seven Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty Eight) may be withdrawn from the Treasury Fund and expended as authorised in the Schedule to this Act, in payment for goods and services obtained or ordered for the Republic until this Act shall cease to have effect in accordance with Section 2.

NAURU HOUSING FUND

4: Where moneys are withdrawn from the Treasury Fund and expended as authorised in the Schedule to this Act for the erection, maintenance and repair of Nauruan Housing, the Treasury Fund shall be reimbursed from the Nauru Housing Fund to the extent of the expenditure and the Nauru Housing Fund hereby charged accordingly.

INCOME FROM NAURUAN HOUSING

5: All deposits, purchase moneys, rentals, interests and other moneys paid in respect of the erection, maintenance or repair of Nauruan Housing provided in accordance with the expenditure authorised by Section 4 or the disposal of any assets acquired in connection therewith, shall be paid to the Nauru Housing Fund.
