Applications are invited from persons inside and outside the Public Service for employment in the following positions:

POLICE DEPARTMENTDirector of Police

Qualifications: Sound experience in the administration, training and direction of a Police Force. The appointee will be mature and of good physique and it is desirable that he have some background of immigration control and prison administration.

Duties: The successful applicant will be responsible for the direction and control of the Nauru Police Force which has an establishment of 53 Nauruans. He will be required to interpret for working purposes, the language of statutes and to apply the criminal code. As well as acting as Immigration and Passports Officer, Fire Officer, Licensing Authority and Collector of Customs, he will have overall charge of the Nauru Prison.

WORKS DEPARTMENTClerk of Works (Housing)

Qualifications: Carpentry or bricklaying qualifications together with not less than five years experience in a supervisory capacity on building works, preferably housing. Formal training for the responsibilities of Foreman or Clerk of Works will be an advantage.

Duties: The appointee will be responsible to the Director of Works for major construction and repair works on housing in all trades. He will be required to order and maintain supplies of materials to sites, contribute to on-the-job training of young Nauruans as well as allocate and supervise the labour force.
