NAURU PHOSPHATE ROYALTIES

(PAYMENT AND INVESTMENT)

ORDINANCE 1968

By virtue of the provisions of Section 30 (2) (c) of the above Ordinance I am required to publish or cause to be published a summary of the Annual Report of the Nauru Royalties Trust in the Government Gazette.

I append below a summary of the Nauru Phosphate Royalties Trust Report dated 7th September, 1973 for the financial year ended the 30th June, 1973.

1. Trustees

Members at 30th June, 1973 were:

2. Funds Administered by the Trust

Persuant to the provisions of Sections 18 and 19 of the Ordinance the Long Term Investment Fund and the Nauru Land Owners Royalties Trust Fund are administered by the Trust and in addition certain other Funds, being the Nauru Rehabilitation Fund and the Nauru Housing Fund are administered by the Trust persuant to a direction given under Section 22 of the Ordinance.

3. Investment Policy

Important changes in the standing approvals under Section 25 of the Ordinance were made during the year, the manner, nature and condition of which are materially different from those of prior financial periods.

4. Loan Investment

As part of its investment programme the Trust has made a number of selective fixed interest loans during the year under review.

5. Equity Investments

During the year the Trust took the opportunity of making additional selective purchases. A number of Shares were also sold, realising substantial profits.

6. Real Estate Investments

The Trust has now completed all advances to Trans Australian Airlines. The Trust also received Cabinet approval for a substantial city property development, which the Long Term Investment Fund and the Nauruan Landowners Royalty Trust Fund are jointly participating.

7. Audit of Trust Accounts

An Audit Certificate without qualification has been issued by the Auditors, Messrs. Cooper and Lybrand, Chartered Accountants, Melbourne.
