CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ACT 1972SECTIONS 47 AND 48DELEGATION OF POWERS AND DUTIES OFDIRECTOR OF PUBLIC PROSECUTIONSAND APPOINTMENT OFPUBLIC PROSECUTOR

I, DAVID GEOFFREY LANG, being the Director of Public Prosecutions appointed pursuant to the provisions of Section 45 of the Criminal Procedure Act 1972 DO HEREBY, pursuant to provisions of Section 47 of the Criminal Procedure Act 1972, authorise RODNEY JAMES HOOKER an officer of the Department of Justice, to exercise all or any of the powers and rights vested, or duties imposed upon the Director of Public Prosecutions by virtue of the Sections 46, 180, 181 182 and 185 of the Criminal Procedure Act 1972, AND FURTHER, pursuant to Section 48 of the Criminal Procedure Act 1972 appoint RODNEY JAMES HOOKER, a public officer of the Department of Justice qualified to be admitted to practice as a Barrister and Solicitor to be Public Prosecutor in general.

PROVIDED that this authority shall not in any manner or form derogate from the powers and duties of the Director of Public Prosecutions.

BANK OF NAURU ACT 1976
SECTIONS 6(1), 8(1) AND 11(1)

APPOINTMENT OF THE BOARD AND CHAIRMAN OF
THE BANK OF NAURU

On behalf of the Cabinet, I, PETER LIONEL JONES, Secretary to the Cabinet HEREBY NOTIFY -

FIRST that the Cabinet in exercise of its powers under section 11(1) of the Bank of Nauru Act 1976 (hereinafter called "the Act") HEREBY TERMINATES the appointment of all persons who heretofore were Directors of the Bank of Nauru.

SECONDLY that the Cabinet in exercise of its powers under section 6(1) of the Act HEREBY DETERMINES that the Board of the Bank of Nauru shall for the time being be constituted by six Directors.

THIRDLY that in further exercise of its powers under section 6(1) of the Act the Cabinet HEREBY APPOINTS the following six persons to be Directors of the Bank of Nauru with immediate effect for a period expiring on the thirtieth day of June, 1979 (unless sooner terminated under section 11(1) of the Act):

FOURTHLY that the Cabinet in exercise of its powers under section 6(7) of the Act HEREBY DETERMINES that the Bank shall not pay any fees to any Director of the Bank of Nauru.

FIFTHLY (and lastly) that the Cabinet in exercise of its powers under section 8(1) of the Act HEREBY APPOINTS R. B. DETUDAMO to be the Chairman of the Board of Directors with immediate effect and for a period expiring on the thirtieth day of June 1979 (unless and sooner revoked under section 8(3) of the Act).
