PUBLIC SERVICE ACT 1961 - 1979SECTION 27 (2) - NAURUAN BASIC WAGE

IN EXERCISE of the powers vested in me under Section 27(2) of the Public Service Act 1961 - 1979, I, BURARO DETUDAMO, Minister responsible for the Public Service, HEREBY ADVISE THAT the reviews have been carried out on the Retail Price Index of Commodities and HEREBY DETERMINE that the following basic wage rates shall take effect from the 18 May, 1984, which is the first local payday following the 15th May, 1984.

Adult	-	\$5410 p.a.
20 years of Age (90%)	-	\$4869 p.a.
19 years of Age (70%)	-	\$3787 p.a.
18 years of Age (60%)	-	\$3246 p.a.
17 years of Age (55%)	-	\$2976 p.a.
16 years of Age (50%)	-	\$2705 p.a.
