CONSTITUTION OF NAURU

ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE BUSINESS OF GOVERNMENT

IN EXERCISE of the powers in that behalf vested in His Excellency the President, under Article 23 of the Constitution of Nauru, I, BURARO DETUDAMO, being the Minister exercising the functions of His Excellency the President in Nauru under and by virtue of appointment as such by Cabinet under Article 21 of the Constitution of Nauru, hereby assign to the Minister of the Cabinet of Nauru, as set out below the responsibilities of the Business of the Government of Nauru as set out opposite his name:

MINISTER OF CABINET

MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND
EDUCATION

BUSINESS OF GOVERNMENT

The portfolio of the Minister for Justice in relation to the Business of Government to be undertaken in Nauru by the said Minister.

The assignment of the Business of the Government of Nauru as set out above is in addition to and not in substitution for the Business of the Government of Nauru already assigned to the said Minister. The above assignment of responsibility for the Business of the Government shall be effective during the absence from the Republic of the Honourable Bernard Dowiyogo, M.P. Minister for Justice.

LEGAL PRACTITIONERS ACT 1979
PLEADERS (TRAINING AND EXAMINATIONS)
RULES 1985

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on me by Section 57 of the legal practitioners Act 1973 and in supersession of all existing Rules on the subject, I hereby make the following rules:

TITLE

1. (1) These Rules may be cited as the Pleaders (Training and Examinations) Rules 1985.
- (2) They shall come into operations on the 22nd day of August 1985.

INTERPRETATION

2. In these rules -
 - a) "Act" means the Legal Practitioners Act 1973,
 - b) "Schedule" means a Schedule to these rules.

TRAINING OF PLEADERS

3. 1) For the purposes of Section 11 of the Act, the training which a person is required to have undergone in order to be qualified for admission as a pleader is the series of courses of instruction in the law which are specified in the First Schedule:

2) Where any person has participated in part but not the whole of any courses of instruction, the Chief Justice shall determine, after consultation with the person who provided that course of instruction, whether such participation was sufficient for that first-mentioned person to be regarded as having undergone the training required for qualification for admission as a pleader.

EXAMINATIONS

4. For the purposes of Section 11 of the Act, the examinations which a person is required to have passed in order to be qualified for admission as a pleader are those specified in the Second Schedule:

Provided that, where any person who attended the course of instruction in any subject has been unable, for reasons beyond his control, to take the examination in that subject, the Chief Justice may exempt that person from the requirement of having passed that examination but, if he does so, he shall require that person to pass another examination in that subject before such date as the Chief Justice may, from time to time, determine.

Provided further that, where any person who has attended the course of instruction in any subject has taken the examination in that subject but has not passed it, the Chief Justice may exempt that person from the requirement of having passed that examination but he shall not so exempt any person who has previously failed to take, otherwise than for reasons beyond his control, or has previously taken but not passed, examinations in two subjects, and, if he exempts any such person from the requirement of having passed the examination in any subject, he shall require that person to pass another examination in that subject before such date as the Chief Justice, may from time to time, determine.

Provided also that, where any person has passed an examination set by a university in any country in any subject which is the subject of any of the examinations referred to in this paragraph, the Chief Justice, if he is satisfied that the standard required by that university for a pass in its examination is sufficiently high, may, upon proof of that person having passed the examination of that university, exempt him from having to pass in respect of the subject of that examination, the examination referred to in this rule and, for the purposes of Section 11 of the Act, a person so exempted shall be deemed to have passed the said examination referred to in this paragraph.

APPOINTMENT OF INSTRUCTORS AND EXAMINERS, ETC.

5. The Chief Justice may -
- (i) for the training of pleaders under these rules appoint such instructors and fix such periods in relation to each course of instruction, as he may, from time to time, consider fit;
 - (ii) for the conduct of examinations under these rules, from time to time, fix such dates of examinations and either act himself as examiner in relation to all or any of the subjects of examinations or appoint such examiners, as he may consider fit.

PROVISIONAL ADMISSION OF PLEADERS

6. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing rules, a trainee who, has passed the subjects of examinations specified in Serial Numbers 1 to 7 of the Second Schedule, may on an application made by him and on payment of such fee as the Minister may by regulations, prescribe in that behalf, be provisionally admitted as a pleader and practice as such in relation to criminal matters only in the District Court:

Provided that the Chief Justice, may, in his discretion, allow any such provisionally admitted pleader to appear in relation to any particular criminal matter in the Supreme Court.

Provided further that where any such provisionally admitted pleader fails to pass the remaining subjects of examination, his provisional admission as a pleader and entitlement to practice as aforesaid, shall cease to have effect forthwith.

PROVISIONAL ADMISSION WHEN TO CEASE TO BE EFFECTIVE

7. Nothing in Rule 6 shall be construed to affect the applicability of the Legal Practitioners (Admission) Rules 1973 in relation to any person provisionally admitted as Pleader and the provisional admission as a Pleader of any such person and his entitlement to practise as such, shall cease to be effective on the expiry of a period of thirty days from the date of his passing the remaining subjects of examination unless the Chief Justice, in his absolute discretion, extends period.

REPEAL

8 The Pleaders (Training and Examinations) Rules 1975 as amended from time to time, are hereby repealed.

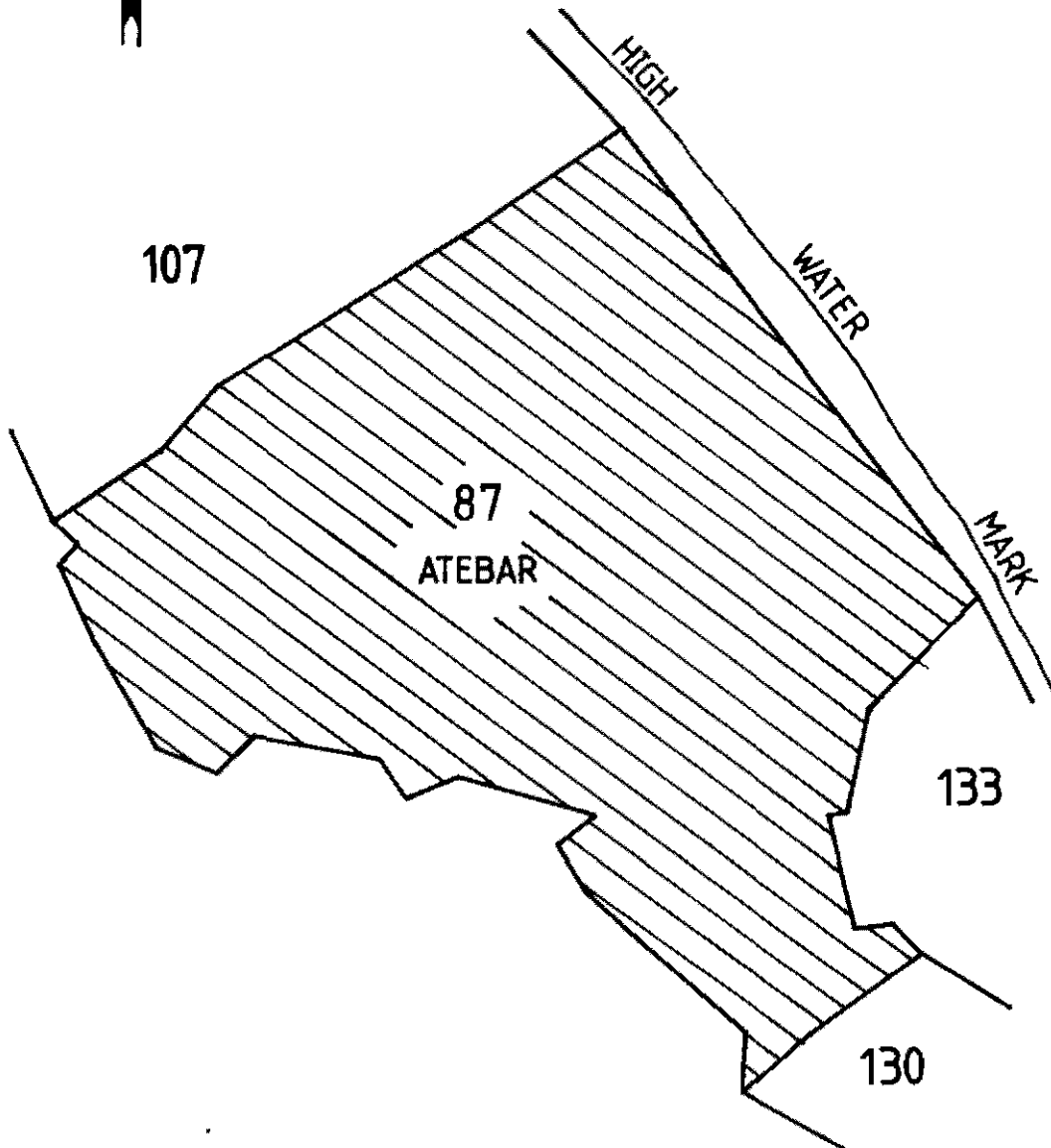
