AN ORDINANCE

Relating to Duties of Customs.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Customs* Short title.
(*Export*) *Tariff*, 1920.
2. The *Customs Ordinance, 1909-1916*, shall be incor- Incorporation.
porated and read as one with this Ordinance.
3. The Duties of Customs specified in the Schedule Export Duties
of Customs.
to this Ordinance are hereby imposed according to this Schedule as on and from the twelfth day of November One thousand nine hundred and twenty and such duties shall be deemed to have been imposed on such last-mentioned

date and shall be charged collected and paid to the use of the King for the purposes of the Territory of Papua on all goods dutiable under the Schedule exported from the said Territory and on and after the date when such duties are deemed to have been imposed.

Passed in Council this twelfth day of November, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and twenty.
