**AN ORDINANCE**

*To Exclude Certain Native Offenders from Towns.*

**B**E it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Native Offenders Exclusion Ordinance, 1930.* Short title.
2. No native convicted of any offence of an indecent nature against a white woman or girl shall upon discharge from custody come or remain within the boundaries of any town. Exclusion from towns.

Penalty.

**3.** Any native convicted of a breach of the provisions of this Ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanour and is liable to imprisonment with hard labour for one year.

Passed in Council this fifteenth day of July, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty.
