AN ORDINANCE

To Amend the "Superannuation Ordinance, 1917-1920."

[Reserved 23rd September, 1921;

Assented to 21st December, 1921.] (a)

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Super-short title and annuation Ordinance, 1921.
- (2) The Superannuation Ordinance, 1917-1920, is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.
- (3) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the Superannuation Ordinance, 1917-1921.
- 2. Section thirty-two of the Principal Ordinance Absence on is amended by the addition at the end of Subsection pay to count thirteen of the following proviso:—

 Absence on leave without pay to count in cartain cases.

"Provided always that the Lieutenant-Governor may specially order in any case that such period shall be counted in computing the superannuation allowance or gratuity; the order may be subject to such conditions as to the payment of contributions and otherwise as the Lieutenant-Governor may approve and may apply to a period of absence without leave which expired before the passing of this Ordinance."

Power to cancel order excepting officer from the provisions of the Principal Ordinance.

- 3. The Principal Ordinance is amended by the insertion after Section 16 of Section 16A as follows:—
 - "16a. An officer who has been excepted by order of the Lieutenant-Governor from the provisions of the Principal Ordinance may apply to the Lieutenant-Governor for cancellation of the order and the Lieutenant-Governor may cancel the order subject to such payment of contributions and interest thereon as he may approve."
- 4. Section 13A (4) of the Principal Ordinance is amended by the substitution of the word "twelve" for the word "six."
 - Passed in Council this twenty-third day of September, in the year of Our Lord One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one.
 - Assented to by His Excellency the Governor-General, with the advice of the Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Australia, on the Twenty-first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one.
