

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 8 of 1929.

Made under the *Cemeteries Ordinance*, 1911 (No. 8 of 1912).

The Port Moresby Public Cemetery By-laws of the second day of June, One thousand nine hundred and thirteen, are amended as follows:—

By repealing Schedule B thereof and substituting the following in lieu thereof:—
