

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 16 of 1934.

Made under *The Mining Act of 1898* (Queensland Adopted).

The *Mining Regulations, 1923* (Statutory Rules No. 5 of 1923), are further amended as follows:—

1. By repealing Regulation 144 and inserting in lieu thereof the following new regulation:—

“ *Quarterly statement of operations.* ”

144. The owner or manager of every mine for which registration is required shall within the first ten days of every quarter furnish the Director of Mines through the Warden with a statement in duplicate of the work done in or in connection with such mine during the preceding three months. Such statement shall be in the following form:—

Any owner or manager who neglects or refuses to furnish such statement shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Five pounds for the first offence and not exceeding Ten pounds for the second or any subsequent offence.”
