

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 3 of 1919.

MADE UNDER "THE NATIVE REGULATION ORDINANCE OF 1908"
(No. XXV. of 1909).

1. The Regulations dealing with Native Matters, made under *The Native Regulation Ordinance of 1908*, on the fifteenth day of March, 1911, and published in the *Gazette* dated the 24th day of April, 1911, are further amended by inserting after paragraph (3) of Regulation 80, the following paragraph—

"(3A) When any native has been released from custody as being free from venereal disease he may be ordered by a magistrate to present himself thereafter at such place and at such intervals as the magistrate may specify for examination by a doctor or a magistrate; and such native shall so present himself accordingly. Provided that no native who has been discharged from custody on the advice or certificate of a doctor shall be so ordered to present himself unless such doctor shall request such an order to be made."
