

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 8 of 1930.

Made under *The Native Regulation Ordinance* of 1908.

The *Native Regulations*, 1922 (Statutory Rules No. 3 of 1922), are further amended as follows:—

1. By inserting therein immediately after Regulation 93 thereof the following new regulation and heading:—

“Saving of Babies.

93A. If the mother of a child still at the breast dies it is the duty of the Village Constable to see whether there is anybody capable and willing to feed it and if there is not, to take the child to the nearest hospital when such a course is practicable.”
