

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 9 of 1918.

Made under *The Native Regulation Ordinance of 1908* (No. XXV. of 1909).

1. The Regulations dealing with Native Matters made under *The Native Regulation Ordinance of 1908*, on the fifteenth day of March, 1911, and published in *Gazette* dated the twenty-fourth day of April, 1911, are further amended by inserting therein after Regulation 119 the following new Regulation :—

Picture Shows.

“ 120. No native shall without first obtaining the permission of a Resident Magistrate take any part in the representation of any scene or incident which is being photographed for the purpose of being or which when photographed is capable of being reproduced in moving pictures or in living pictures of dramatic character.”
