

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 6 of 1923.

REGULATIONS

Made under the provisions of *The Public Service Ordinance of 1907*, (No. 2 of 1907).

The Public Service Regulations, 1922, (Statutory Rules No. 2 of 1923) are amended—

(a) by omitting from paragraph (4) of Regulation 67 thereof all the words commencing "In the case of all other officers" down to the end of the said paragraph (4); and

(b) by inserting after paragraph (4) of Regulation 67 thereof, the following new paragraph:—

"(4A). In the case of officers other than those mentioned in paragraph (4) of this Regulation overtime shall for the same purposes mean time worked with the sanction aforesaid in excess of such a number of hours a day (not being less than eight hours a day) as is expressed in the writing sanctioning the payment."

(c) by inserting at the end of paragraph (2) of Regulation 68 thereof the following words:—

"or at such other rate and in respect of such other hours as shall be expressed in the writing sanctioning the payment."
