

STATUTORY RULES.

No. 5 of 1938.

Made under *The Public Service Ordinance of 1907.*

The *Public Service Regulations, 1926* (Statutory Rules No. 9 of 1926), are further amended:—

1. By repealing Regulation 34 thereof and substituting the following in its stead:—

“ Higher Duties Allowance.

34. When an officer performs the duties of an office of a higher grade than his own continuously for any period not being less than thirty days he shall be granted an allowance for the period he performs such duties at a rate equal to the difference between the maximum salary of his grade (to which shall be added any long-service increment being paid to the officer) and the minimum salary of the higher grade.”
