

AMENDMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE REGULATIONS. ⁽¹⁾⁽²⁾

Regulations.

No. 7 of 1951.

Commencement. 1. Unless otherwise specified herein, these regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the ninth day of November, One thousand nine hundred and fifty.

Maximum rate for purposes of Section 28 (15.) of Ordinance, Hours of duty.

2. Regulation 25 of the *Public Service Regulations* is amended by omitting the words "Five hundred and sixteen" and inserting in their stead the words "Six hundred and eight".

3. Regulation 29 of the *Public Service Regulations* is omitted and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—

"29.—(1.) The hours of duty of Officers shall be thirty-six and three-quarter hours per week, and, unless the Commissioner otherwise approves, the hours of attendance shall be—

Monday to Friday—8 a.m. to 12 noon; and 1.30 p.m. to 4.0³ p.m.
Saturday—8 a.m. to 12 noon.

[(2.) *Officers shall not be scheduled for—*

- (a) *more than five hours' duty without a meal break;*
(b) *a meal break exceeding one and one-half hours duration; or*
(c) *a shift including more than one meal break.*"]⁽³⁾

Standard salaries of Officers of First Division.

4. Regulation 53 of the *Public Service Regulations* is amended—
(a) by omitting the table from sub-regulation (1.) and inserting in its stead the following table:—

(b) by omitting paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (3.) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:—

Standard salaries of Officers of Third Division.

6. Regulation 57 of the *Public Service Regulations* is amended—

(a) by omitting from Table A in sub-regulation (1.) the figures “224 230 236 242 248”; and

(b) by omitting from Table B in that sub-regulation the figures “162 168 174 180 186”.

Overtime.

7. Regulation 60 of the *Public Service Regulations* is amended by omitting sub-regulation (3.)

Calculation of overtime payment.

8. Regulation 63 of the *Public Service Regulations* is amended—

(a) by omitting from sub-regulation (4.) the symbol and figures “£516” and inserting in their stead the symbol and figures “£608”; and

(b) by omitting from sub-regulation (5.) the symbol and figures “£914” and inserting in their stead the symbol and figures “£1,040”.

Officer in receipt of standard salary in excess of £1,040 per annum.

9. Regulation 65 of the *Public Service Regulations* is amended by omitting from paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (1.) the symbol and figures “£914” and inserting in their stead the symbol and figures “£1,040”.

Territorial allowance.

10.—(1.) Regulation 68 of the *Public Service Regulations* is amended by adding at the end of sub-regulation (1.) the following proviso:—

“Provided that a married male Officer shall, in respect of any period during which his wife is employed in the Territory by the Commonwealth or by the Administration, be paid Territorial allowance at the rate prescribed for an unmarried Officer”.

(2.) This regulation shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of January, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one.

11. Regulation 70 of the *Public Service Regulations* is amended— Higher duties allowance.
- (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (3.) the symbol and figures “£471” and inserting in their stead the symbol and figures “£560”;
 - (b) by omitting from sub-regulation (4.) the symbol and figures “£471” and inserting in their stead the symbol and figures “£560”; and
 - (c) by omitting from sub-regulation (7.) the symbol and figures “£471” and inserting in their stead the symbol and figures “£560”.
12. Regulation 89 of the *Public Service Regulations* is amended— Grant of passages of Officers proceeding on leave.
- (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (12.) the words “the amount” and inserting in their stead the words “the net amount”; and
 - (b) by inserting in that sub-regulation after the word “charged” the words “to the Administration”.
- 13.—(1.) Regulation 117 is amended— Rates of pay, allowances and hours of duty.
- (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (2.) the words “whose husband is resident in the Territory shall not be paid Territorial allowance” and inserting in their stead the words “shall be paid Territorial allowance at the rate prescribed for an unmarried Officer”; and
 - (b) by omitting sub-regulation (3.).
- (2.) This regulation shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of January, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-one.
14. The First Schedule to the *Public Service Regulations* is amended— The First Schedule.
- (a) by omitting from the first column the words and figures “Cadet Draftsman (£114-£381)” and inserting in their stead the words and figures “Cadet Draftsman (£130-£416)”;
 - (b) by omitting from the second column, in relation to the office of “Cadet Draftsman (£130-£416)” the symbol and figures “£381” and inserting in their stead the symbol and figures “£416”;
 - (c) by omitting from the first column the words and figures “Draftsman, Grade 1 (£381-£606), Department of Lands” and inserting in their stead the words and figures “Draftsman, Grade 1 (£416-£704), Department of Lands, Surveys and Mines”;
 - (d) by omitting from the second column, in relation to the office of “Draftsman, Grade 1 (£416-£704), Department of Lands, Surveys and Mines”, the symbol and figures “£471” (twice occurring) and inserting in their stead the symbol and figures “£560”;
 - (e) by omitting from the first column the words and figures “Legal Officer, Grade 1 (£162-£606)” and inserting in their stead the words and figures “Legal Officer, Grade 1 (£186-£704)”;

- (f) by omitting from the second column, in relation to the office of "Legal Officer, Grade 1 (£186-£704)", the symbols and figures "£381" and "£449" and inserting in their stead the symbols and figures "£416" and "£524" respectively;
- (g) by omitting from the first column the words and figures "Librarian (Female) (£274-£409)" and inserting in their stead the words and figures "Librarian (Female) (£306-£498)";
- (h) by omitting from the second column, in relation to the office of "Librarian (Female) (£306-£498)" the symbol and figures "£319" (twice occurring) and inserting in their stead the symbol and figures "£354";
- (i) by omitting from the second column, in relation to the office of "Librarian (Female) (£306-£498)" the symbol and figures "£342" and inserting in their stead the symbol and figures "£390";
- (j) by inserting after the reference to the office of "Librarian (Female) (£306-£498)" and the conditions of advancement relating thereto the following office and conditions of advancement:—

"Medical Officer, Grade 2 (£1,224- £1,472)	He shall not be advanced beyond £1,348 per annum unless he is in possession of the Diploma of Public Health or the Diploma of Tropical Medicine."

- (k) by omitting from the first column the words and figures "Patrol Officer (£291-£606)" and inserting in their stead the words and figures "Patrol Officer (£320-£704)";
- (l) by omitting from the second column, in relation to the office of "Patrol Officer (£320-£704)" the symbols and figures "£471" and "£539" and inserting in their stead the symbols and figures "£560" and "£632" respectively;
- (m) by adding at the end of the conditions of advancement prescribed in relation to the office of "Patrol Officer (£320-704)" the following paragraph:—

"(3) Officers—

- (a) who have passed an examination for District Officer or Assistant District Officer held in pursuance of Regulations made under the *Public Service Ordinance 1922-1940* of the Territory of New Guinea; or
- (b) who before the ninth day of November, One thousand nine hundred and fifty, acted as Assistant District Officer or as District Officer for a period of not less than three years and whom the Director of District Services and Native Affairs has certified to be capable of performing efficiently the whole of the duties of Assistant District Officer, shall be exempted from the conditions prescribed in the last two preceding paragraphs."
- (n) by omitting from the first column the words and figures "Inspector (£381-£606), Native Labour Branch, Department of the Government Secretary" and inserting in their stead the words and figures "Inspector (£416-£704), Native Labour Branch, Department of the Government Secretary"; and

- (o) by omitting from the second column, in relation to the office of "Inspector (£416-£704), Native Labour Branch, Department of the Government Secretary", the symbol and figures "£471" and inserting in their stead the symbol and figures "£560".

15. The Second Schedule to the *Public Service Regulations* is The Second Schedule. repealed and the following Schedule inserted in its stead:—
