

LIQUOR REGULATIONS. ⁽¹⁾

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Liquor Regulations*. ⁽¹⁾ Short title.
2. In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears— Definitions.
 “The Ordinance” means the *Liquor Ordinance 1931* ⁽²⁾ as amended from time to time.
- 3.—(1.) The Clerk shall keep a register in which shall be entered a minute of every application, decision, order, or proceeding, under the Ordinance. Duties of Clerk.
 (2.) The Clerk, forthwith on receipt of notice of a proposed application under the Ordinance, shall forward a copy of the application to the Chief Licensing Inspector.
4. The hours from seven o'clock in the morning to twelve o'clock noon of the twenty-fifth day of April shall be prohibited hours for the purposes of the Ordinance. Prohibition of sale on portion of 25th April.
- 4A. The prescribed fee payable in respect of a licence under section 18A of the Ordinance shall be Four hundred pounds per annum. Fee for licence under section 18A.

Fee for publican's licence.

5. The prescribed fees payable in respect of publican's licences are the fees set out in the First Schedule to these Regulations.

Fee for storekeeper's licence.

6. The prescribed fees payable in respect of storekeeper's licences are the fees set out in the Second Schedule to these Regulations.

Fee for packet licence.

7. The prescribed fee payable in respect of a packet licence shall be Ten pounds per annum.

Fee for club licence.

8.—(1.) The annual fee to be paid for a club licence shall be Fifteen pounds and in addition Three shillings for every member of the club.

(2.) For the purpose of computing the annual fee to be paid for a club licence, the number of members of a club shall be deemed to be the number of members on the day of the grant of the application for the club licence or the renewal of the club licence, as the case may be.

Setting-down fee.

9. A fee of Ten shillings for setting down the application shall be lodged with the Clerk with every notice of a proposed application under the Ordinance for the grant, transfer, or renewal of a publican's licence, a storekeeper's licence, or a club licence.

9A.—(1.) Notice of application for a permit under section 35 of the Ordinance shall be given in writing to the inspector and the Clerk at least seven days before the application is made.

(2.) A fee of Ten shillings for setting down the application shall be paid to the Clerk at the time the notice of application is lodged.

Fees to be paid to Clerk.

10. Any fee payable under the Ordinance or these Regulations shall be paid to the Clerk.

Plans.

11. Every plan lodged under sections 39, 40, or 41 of the Ordinance shall show the details set out in the Fourth Schedule to these Regulations.

Order cancelling licence.

12. The order referred to in section 82 of the Ordinance shall be in accordance with Form 1 in the Fifth Schedule to these Regulations.
