

# TOWN BOUNDARIES ORDINANCE

## 1924-1927. <sup>(1)</sup>

### An Ordinance to provide for the Declaration of Town Boundaries.

**B**E it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *New Guinea Act* 1920, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Town Boundaries Ordinance* 1924-1927. <sup>(1)</sup>

2. In any Ordinance, unless the contrary intention appears—“Town” includes the towns of Rabaul, Kokopo, Kavieng, Madang, Morobe and Kieta and such other place as the Administrator declares by notice <sup>(2)</sup> published in the *New Guinea Gazette* to be a town.

3. The Administrator may, by notice <sup>(3)</sup> published in the *New Guinea Gazette*, declare any place in the Territory to be a town and set forth and declare the boundaries of any town in the Territory.
