Appropriation (National Development Expenditure) Act 1996.

Being an Act to grant and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund a sum for the National Development Expenditure for the year ending 31 December 1997 and to appropriate the supplies granted for that year.

MADE by the National Parliament.

1. GRANT OF K421,234,400.00.

Subject to authorization from the Minister, the Secretary for Finance may issue out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and apply for the National development expenditure for the financial year ending 31 December 1997 the sum of K421,234,400.00.

2. APPROPRIATION.

Sums granted by this Act out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the National development expenditure for the financial year ending 31 December 1997 are appropriated for the approved projects to be implemented by Agencies expressed in the Schedule in relation to the financial year ending 31 December 1997.

3. ADJUSTMENT OF APPROPRIATION AS BETWEEN SERVICES.

Where there is insufficient appropriation to meet development expenditure the Secretary for Finance may direct the re-allocation of any unexpended appropriation under development expenditure to approved projects, provided that the total reallocation shall not exceed a sum of K2,000,000.00.

4. DIRECTION TO BE AVAILABLE TO AUDITOR-GENERAL.

A copy of each direction under Section 3 shall be made available to the Auditor-General as soon as practicable after the end of each quarter of the financial year ending 31 December 1997.
