Being an Act to amend the *Constitutional and Law Reform Commission Act 2004* and for related purposes,

MADE by the National Parliament.

1. INTERPRETATION (AMENDMENT OF SECTION 1).

Section 1 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the definition of "Secretary", the following:-

""Speaker" means the Speaker of the National Parliament;"

2. FUNCTIONS OF THE COMMISSION (AMENDMENT OF SECTION 12).

Section 12 of the Principal Act is amended in -

(a) Subsection (1) by adding after the words "or advice" the following:-

"or the Speaker, on a resolution of the Parliament"; and

(b) Subsection (2), by adding after the words "or otherwise", the following:-

"or the Speaker, on a resolution of the Parliament"; and

(c) Subsection (3) by adding after the words "the Minister", the following:-

"or the Speaker".

3. **REPORTS (AMENDMENT OF SECTION 15).**

Section 15 of the Principal Act is amended –


(a) in Subsection (1) by adding after the words "on advice" the following:-

"or the Speaker"; and


(b) in Subsection (2)(a) by adding after the words "the Minister", the following:-

"or the Speaker".
