

PUBLIC SERVICE (DEDUCTION FROM SALARIES) ORDINANCE, 1930.⁽¹⁾

No. 13 of 1930.

An Ordinance to authorize the Deduction of Amounts from Salaries of Officers of the Public Service.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Public Service (Deduction from Salaries) Ordinance, 1930.*⁽¹⁾ Short title.

2. This Ordinance shall commence on a date to be fixed by the Lieutenant-Governor by Proclamation in the *Gazette.*⁽¹⁾ Commencement.

3. In this Ordinance unless the context or subject-matter otherwise requires:— Interpretation.

“Lieutenant-Governor”⁽²⁾ means the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.⁽²⁾

“Officer” means any person in the Public Service of the Territory of Papua.

“Public Service” means the Public Service of the Territory of Papua.

“Salary” means the remuneration for the time being received by any officer and does not apply to allowances.

4. Deductions shall be made month by month from the salaries of all officers at a rate to be fixed⁽³⁾ from time to time by the Lieutenant-Governor⁽²⁾ provided that such rate shall not exceed ten per centum. Rate of deduction.

Application of
moneys.

5. All moneys deducted in pursuance of the provisions of this Ordinance shall belong to and form part of the Public Revenue of the Territory of Papua.

Refunds.

6. The Lieutenant-Governor⁽²⁾ may order any moneys deducted in pursuance of this Ordinance to be refunded to the officer entitled thereto.

Saving.

7. Nothing herein contained shall affect the rate of salary for the purpose of the *Superannuation Ordinance, 1917-1927*.⁽⁴⁾

Suspension
of operation.

8. The Lieutenant-Governor⁽²⁾ may at any time by proclamation⁽⁵⁾ in the *Gazette* suspend the operation of this Ordinance.

Regulations.

9. The Lieutenant-Governor⁽²⁾ may make Regulations⁽⁶⁾ necessary or convenient for carrying this Ordinance into effect.
