

WRITS OF DEDIMUS ORDINANCE, 1912.⁽¹⁾

No. 19 of 1912.

An Ordinance to authorize the issuing of Writs of Dedimus Potestatem and Commissions for taking Affidavits within and without the Territory of Papua.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor of the Territory of Papua with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Writs of Dedimus Ordinance, 1912*⁽¹⁾. It shall commence on a day to be fixed by the Lieutenant-Governor by Proclamation published in the *Gazette*.⁽¹⁾ Short title.

2. “*The Writs of Dedimus Act of 1871*” (Queensland adopted) is repealed. Repeal.

3. Writs of *dedimus potestatem* and commissions for taking affidavits in the Central Court⁽²⁾ may be issued as has been the practice heretofore and may be executed within and without the Territory. Writs of *dedimus potestatem* and commissions for affidavits.
