National Airline Commission Act 1973

APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRMAN AND VICE-CHAIRMAN OF THE NATIONAL AIRLINE COMMISSION

I, Bruce Jephcott, Minister for Transport and Works, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 11(a) and (b) of the *National Airline Commission Act 1973* and all other powers me enabling, hereby—

- (a) appoint, by agreement with Qantas Airways Limited, the Australian National Airlines Commission trading as Trans-Australia Airlines and Ansett Transport Industries Limited, Paul Pora to be the Chairman of the National Airline Commission for a period of three months commencing on and from the date of gazettal of this instrument in the *National Gazette*; and

Central Banking Act 1973

DETERMINATION OF THE PAR VALUE OF THE KINA

I, John Guise, G.C.M.G., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 48(1) of the Central Banking Act 1973 and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, after consultation with the Bank of Papua New Guinea and in accordance with any international agreement to which Papua New Guinea is a party, hereby—

(a) revoke the notice of Determination of par value of the kina dated 23rd July, 1976, and published in National Gazette No. 65 of 5th August, 1976; and

(b) determine that the par value of the kina shall be equal to one dollar eighteen and twelve hundredths cents (\$1.1812), in the currency of Australia,

with effect on and from 6 p.m. on 28th November, 1976.

Firearms Regulation Act 1963

AMNESTY

I, John Poe, Minister for Police, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 64(1) of the *Firearms Regulation Act 1963* and all other powers me enabling, hereby declare that where a person, throughout the Bougainville Province, voluntarily surrenders an unregistered firearm, an unlicensed pistol or an unlicensed high-powered firearm to an officer of the Royal Papua New Guinea Constabulary within the period commencing on and from 1st December, 1976 up to and including 31st January, 1977, he shall not be liable to prosecution under that Act arising out of his possession of that firearm.
