## AMENDMENT OF NOTICE OF ESTABLISHMENT OF SUPPLY AND TENDERS BOARD, PAPUA NEW GUINEA OFFICE, SYDNEY

(d) determine that the limits of authority and jurisdiction of the Board shall be to invite tenders for—

(i) the purchase and disposal of stores; and

(ii) the supply of works and services, for and on behalf of the State to a value estimated by the Board not to exceed K100 000.00; and

(e) fix a quorum for a meeting to be three members of whom no more than one shall be a Deputy.”
