*Liquor (Licensing) Act 1963*

## PROHIBITION OF SUPPLY OF LIQUOR

I, Tore Lokoloko, G.C.M.G., O.B.E., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 124 of the *Liquor (Licensing) Act 1963* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby—

- (a) notwithstanding the Liquor Licensing (Trading Hours) Rules 1975 in their application to the National Capital District and the Central Province; and
- (b) notwithstanding any notice in force under Section 124 of the Act; and
- (c) subject to the exceptions specified in the Schedule,

prohibit the supply of liquor under any licence or permit throughout the National Capital District and the Central Province during the period 27th June, 1980 to 13th July, 1980 (inclusive).

### SCHEDULE

*Exceptions:* The provisions of this notice do not apply to—

- (a) the holder of a publican's licence, limited hotel licence or residential club licence who may supply liquor for consumption on licensed premises at any time to lodgers; and
- (b) the holder of a publican's licence, limited hotel licence or restaurant licence who may supply liquor for consumption on licensed premises as part of a meal during the hours when such a licensee would ordinarily be permitted to supply liquor; and
- (c) the holder of a permit granted under Section 76 of the Act; and
- (d) duty free stores.
